

Tier 1:

Student receives 90 minutes per day or more of core classroom instruction. Implement Scientifically Research Based Core Curriculum and address the following:

- Environment welcoming, positive climate, collaborative culture
- <u>High Quality/Differentiated Instruction</u>-purposeful, explicit, student centered, active student engagement, increase learning time, flexible groupings, learning centers, hands-on materials, non-linguistic representations, integrate technology
- <u>Assessment</u> use quality data to drive instruction and on-going communication of data to improve student learning outcomes. Review monitoring data with collaborative teams (e.g. grade level, content area, etc.).
- If student is successful and meets grade level standards, continue with Tier 1 instruction and monitor student progress.
- If student is not successful, provide targeted differentiated intervention in a small group setting within the classroom and continue progress monitoring.

If student is not successful after a minimum of 6-9 weeks of Tier 1 interventions, refer to collaborative team. MTSS Collaborative Team evaluates progress monitoring data and recommends:

- Return to Tier 1 small group (adjust strategy/intensity/duration) OR
- Move to Tier 2 (adjust strategy/intensity/duration)

Tier 2:

Student receives strategic, targeted, small group intervention

- 20 30 minutes per day in addition to 90 minutes of core instruction facilitated by a highly qualified teacher (provide timely, corrective feedback) progress monitoring with documentation
- If student is not being successful after an additional 6-9 weeks of intervention, teacher will provide student's intervention outcome at follow-up meeting.

MTSS Collaborative Team evaluates progress monitoring data and recommends:

- Return to Tier 1 once student outcomes have been met OR
- Continue in Tier 2 small group (adjust strategy/intensity/duration) OR
- Move to Tier 3 (adjust strategy/intensity/duration)

Tier 3:

Student receives intensive, targeted, small group intervention (1:3) or one-to-one (1:1)

- 30-60 minutes per day in addition to 90 minutes core instruction facilitated by a specialist or other highly qualified teacher (provide timely, corrective feedback)
- Continue to monitor, document and review student progress regularly

MTSS Committee evaluates Tier 3 progress monitoring data and recommends:

- Return to Tier 2 once student outcomes have been met OR
- Continue in Tier 3 small group (adjust strategy/intensity/duration) OR
- Decision is made to initiate a referral for district eligibility programs such as Intervention Plan, Section 504, or Special Education

Intervention time will vary depending on progress monitoring based on individual student needs.

Some students will proceed to next steps prior to 6-9 weeks as determined by progress monitoring results.

Time amounts are examples for use in comparing relative times and not intended to be recommendations.

Instructional time will vary depending on circumstances unique to each school.
