**Wexford-Missaukee ISD SCHOOLS OF CHOICE (Section 105):** Any student who resides in a school district **within** the Wexford-Missaukee Intermediate School District may apply for acceptance to his/her school of choice. **SCHOOLS OF CHOICE Section 105C:** "Any student who resides in a school district in an ISD adjacent (a district located in a contiguous ISD) to the Wexford-Missaukee Intermediate School District may apply for acceptance to his/her school of choice. The seven public school districts within the Wexford-Missaukee Intermediate School District accepting applications for enrollment under Schools of Choice **Section 105C** for the 2022-23 school year are: **Cadillac Area Public Schools, Lake City Area Schools, Manton Consolidated Schools, Marion Public Schools, McBain Rural Agricultural School, Mesick Consolidated Schools, and Pine River Area Schools.**

Applications for Schools of Choice can be obtained at the school where the student wishes to attend. An application form must be completed for **each** student wishing to participate in the Schools of Choice Program.

The enrollment period for considering applications for the 2022-23 school year for unlimited enrollment is Wednesday, July 1, 2022 and ending dates below for each school district. The space available in each participating district and the space available at each building determines the number of transfers allowed under the Schools of Choice program. The following openings are available for Schools of Choice transfers for the 2022-23 school year:

**Limited Number of Seats are Offered**

A district having a limited number of spaces and enrolling Section 105 or Section 105c means students will not automatically be enrolled. The district within 15 calendar days after the end of the application period, using the procedures and preferences stated in Section 105 and Section 105c, determine which nonresident applicants will be allowed to enroll in that grade, school, or program through a random draw system.

Random drawing will be done after the open enrollment period has closed. Names will be drawn one at a time and recorded identifying the order. The students that fill the open spots by grade level will be notified. If a student no longer wishes to enroll, the district will contact the first student on the waiting list.

**Unlimited Number of Seats are Offered**

A district having an unlimited number of spaces and enrolling Section 105 or Section 105c means students can automatically be enrolled.
