Elementary scores 57.7 % were above the higher end of national average. Reading goals for half the students improved. 53.3% students have reached their goals.

English Learners students had growth from 31% and now at 41.4%.

6th Grade math saw an 8% increase in the number of students moving to above average.

6th Grade Reading saw a 9% shift from average, 4% moving down and 5% moving to above average.

6th Grade Science saw an increase in below average and a decrease in above average.

7th Grade saw a positive shift across the board towards improved scores in all subjects.

8th grade saw a negative impact across the board in all subjects, except for Algebra 1 had tremendous growth.
